WALKER RIVER RESORT / SIMMONS, STANLEY & LEIA - ZONING - RR-5 - Special use permit issued October 1998 to offer a community clubhouse and recreational center including a sporting clays shooting course, fly fishing classes, basketball and volleyball courts, swimming pool and Jacuzzi and horseback riding on approximately 230 total acres; all located at 251 Copperbelt Road, Smith Valley area (APN's 10-461-03 & 10-461-07) STAFF OBSERVATIONS – Business license is current. Appears to be in use and compliance - No complaints have been received.
